



Psychiatric Hospital Continuum of Services

Description

KidsPeace Children's Hospital is a not-for-profit, acute care inpatient psychiatric hospital for children, preadolescents, teens and young adults. The 80-bed facility provides a fully integrated continuum of 24-hour intensive psychiatric care in a safe, secure, countryside setting of 262 acres. The hospital's mission is to provide a healing environment that supports physical and emotional health. Our clinical services' short-term focus is on patient safety, a comprehensive multidisciplinary clinical assessment and stabilization. We use varied staffing ratios of 1:1, 1:3, 1:4, etc., as required to provide for observation and safety.

Our acute inpatient psychiatric services include a comprehensive psychiatric, psychosocial, educational evaluation and treatment services to address the neuropsychiatric, developmental and behavioral problems of individuals in crisis. Inpatient treatment modalities include: individual, group, family and milieu. Aftercare planning for discharge from the hospital to providers who support children and families services includes referral to KidsPeace Community Mental Health Services and other providers based upon geographic location.

Population Served

KidsPeace Children's Hospital offers individualized treatment plans for four developmental age groups: 6 to 11 year-old children, 11 to 13 year-old preadolescents and 14 to 18 year-old adolescents and young adults 18-21 years old. Children 5 years of age or younger may be evaluated on a case-by-case basis.
