Description

The KidsPeace Autism After School Therapeutic Program is a site-based opportunity for children with an Autism Spectrum Disorder (ASD) diagnosis to develop, practice and generalize a wide variety of social skills with peers. Utilizing an individualized curriculum founded on the principles of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), this program targets relevant social and communication skills to assist each child in reaching his or her full potential. Communication between families and staff is crucial in order to maximize generalization of skills developed in the KidsPeace Autism After School Therapeutic Program.

Population Served

The program serves males and females, 6 to 16 years of age. Individuals entering the program have an active ASD diagnosis and varying degrees of difficulty in interacting socially or communicating their needs.

Services

The highly structured program emphasizes the unique characteristics of each client, and treatment plans are based on the client's individual needs. Services include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Functional assessments
- Individualized orientation processes
- Group and individual skill training
- Individualized termination processes.
- Aftercare follow-up
- Case management
- Family consultation

Treatment Team

Individual treatment plans are designed for each client by an interdisciplinary treatment team that includes the child, family members and the referral source. Teams may be composed of, but not limited to, the following:

- Board certified behavior analysts
- Case manager
- Master's level site supervisor
- Bachelor's level counselors
