



Foster Care and Community Programs Pennsylvania Overview

Description

KidsPeace Foster Care and Community Programs (FCCP) offers an array of service options to children in family-based settings. Services are individualized according to the needs of each child and are provided through a team of professionally trained staff. Some children may be eligible for multiple services, depending on their presenting needs. FCCP offers the following:

- Foster care services to children and youth aged 0-21 with a variety of need-specific levels
- Juvenile Offender Diversion Classes
- Kinship Foster Care
- Violence/Risk/Caregivers Assessments
- Sexual Issues Treatment and Education
- Aftercare Services
- Interstate Compact Home Studies
- Adoption Services
- Emergency Shelter Care
- Diagnostic Foster Care
- Family Group Decision-Making
- Therapeutic Out-of-Home Placement (CRR Host Home) Program
- Respite Care
- Juvenile Offender Programming

Population Served

All programs and services are available for children from birth to age 21 who meet requirements for admission, regardless of race, religion or gender. Children who are actively suicidal, overly aggressive, a danger to themselves or others in the community, active fire-setters or in need of 24-hour awake supervision are not appropriate for FCCP.

Team Members

All FCCP programs and services are child-centered, family-focused, community-based, multi-systemed, culturally competent and least restrictive. Team members vary according to services, and may include:

- KidsPeace caseworkers
- Clinical and/or program managers
- The child's parents, family of origin or guardian
- Foster parents
- Therapists
- BSU representatives
- Board certified psychiatrists
- Master's level therapists
- Licensed clinical psychologists
- Teachers
- Therapeutic staff support
- Placing agency representative.
