



Intensive Outpatient Program Community Programs - Pennsylvania

Description

The Intensive Outpatient Program provides intensive mental health services to children and adolescents who are having difficulty functioning in their community. The program provides intensive individual, family and group therapies on an ambulatory basis while maintaining clients within their home and community. The program focuses on symptom reduction and preventing a decline in functioning, as well as eliminating the need for more restrictive treatment (such as residential, inpatient or partial hospitalization). The program is also a step-down service following an individual's discharge from hospitalization, partial hospitalization or residential care. The program focuses on helping clients achieve a feeling of safety, which will empower them to develop dignity and build character and promote transformation of dysfunctional behaviors into skills for positive daily functioning.

Population Served

Intensive Outpatient serves males and females ages 5 to 18 years who have a mental health diagnosis. Clients admitted to the program suffer from a moderate mental/emotional disturbance that impairs their ability for everyday social, vocational and educational functioning. Clients have some level of independent functioning outside the treatment setting but are in need of guidance to apply the necessary skills to maintain or improve daily functioning.

Services

Clients are expected to participate in individual, group and family therapy as part of their treatment. Other services include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Psychoeducational groups
- Psychiatric medication consultation and/or medication management
- Case management.

Treatment Team

Individualized treatment plans are developed for each client by an interdisciplinary treatment team. The client, family members and referral source assist in developing the plan. Teams may also include:

- Board certified psychiatrists
- Licensed social workers/therapists
- Mental health workers
- Mental health professionals.
