



## **Day Treatment Program – New England**

### **Description**

The Day Treatment Program provides a range of planned and structured services, delivered in the school, home and community, to help students stay with their families; to develop age-appropriate daily living, educational and social skills; and to minimize the need for placement in more restrictive environments such as inpatient or residential settings. The Day Treatment Program encourages academic achievement, social competency and the emotional and physical well being of students.

### **Population Served**

This program serves male and female students from Hancock and Washington Counties (Maine) who are between the ages of 11 and 20 and for whom traditional classroom and public school settings have been unsuccessful. Children appropriate for Day Treatment are considered to have more intensive needs than children enrolled in other outpatient services.

### **Services**

The Day Program integrates and coordinates educational, psychiatric and psychosocial services for the young person who needs a structured, therapeutic setting in order to achieve his/her academic requirements. The KidsPeace New England Day Treatment Program employs the services of a full-time social worker who provides the following services and documentation for all enrolled children:

- Biopsychosocial assessment
- Individual therapy
- Group therapy
- Family therapy
- Progress notes
- Individual service plan
- Case management.

Psychiatric and psychological services are also available. The services offered by these individuals will be prescribed by and carried out in accordance with each child's Individualized Education Plan (IEP).

All children entering the KidsPeace Day Treatment Program receive a diagnostic assessment that includes academic testing, psychological screening and a psychiatric interview. This provides a greater understanding of the students' academic, social, emotional and physical strengths and weaknesses.

### **Treatment Locations**

The Day Treatment Program provides services at the KidsPeace Graham Lake Campus School in Ellsworth, Maine.
