## KidsPeace Holding Open Interview Day at Bethlehem Campus on Wednesday, August 3, 2016

SCHNECKSVILLE, PA (July 27, 2016) - KidsPeace will hold an Open Interview Day on Wednesday, August 3<sup>rd</sup> at its Bethlehem (PA) Campus, for individuals interested in open positions at the 134-year-old provider of mental and behavioral health services for children and adolescents.

On a KidsPeace Open Interview Day, potential applicants can interview with human resources staff or program professionals **without an appointment**. Interviewees must be 21 years old and have a high school diploma/GED and a valid driver's license.

The Open Interview Day will run from 1 p.m. to 6 p.m. at the KidsPeace CDTRC Building, 1620 Broadway, Bethlehem, PA 18015.

Among the positions currently available are:

- **Direct Care Positions** (working directly with children or adolescents), including mental health technicians, RN and LPN nurses, clinicians, therapists, behavioral specialists, teachers, staff for autism programs and other therapeutic staff support, substance abuse therapists and lifeguards.
- Non-Direct Care Positions, including floor technician/custodians, food servers, bus/van drivers, cooks, mechanical trades, and maintenance technicians.
- **Bilingual Spanish Required Positions**, including youth care workers, teachers, clinicians, lead case aides and recreational technician.
