A 2010 inductee into the Christian Music Hall of Fame, Ms. Mason is an award-winning singer, songwriter, teacher and broadcaster who has entertained and inspired audiences around the world for much of the last three decades. She is a sought-after speaker at events throughout the U.S., especially at women's conferences where her message of faith teaches women that they matter and are able to overcome any adversity they may face.
