



## KidsPeace Launches Redesigned TeenCentral Service

Web-based program's therapeutic support offerings for teens expanded, presented in easierto-navigate format; retains individual response capability



SCHNECKSVILLE, PA (June 7, 2017) - Since 1998, KidsPeace has offered therapeutic support to young people through *TeenCentral*, a free and confidential web-based service. Now, **KidsPeace has launched a "reimagined" version of** *TeenCentral* **that provides even more support and guidance for teens** through this free and safe resource.

The new service continues to offer young people the opportunity to post their issues or concerns anonymously and receive an individually crafted response within 24 hours. But the redesigned *TeenCentral* now features a number of significant upgraded capabilities that make it more responsive to the needs of today's youth, including:

- A contemporary visual concept: A modern and streamlined format, providing the user the ability to access content areas, find support helplines and submit stories with ease, as well as a new logo chosen by youth.
- A multifaceted and supportive response: All members of Team TeenCentral receive initial and ongoing
  training for their role as Online Counselors, and are supported by an administrative team of mental
  health professionals throughout their experience. Team TeenCentral includes interns from schools
  such as Cedar Crest College, Marywood University and Portland State University, allowing KidsPeace
  the opportunity to support the educational experience of a new group of human service professionals.

- More clinically driven content: TeenCentral now offers an expanded library of relevant content, blogs and videos on topics such as substance use, relationships, LGBTQ, body image, anxiety, self-injury and depression among others.
- **TeenCentral ToolBox**. A support toolbox offering users a variety of printable tools intended to empower youth and give them concrete interventions to cope with their struggles.

Thespina Godshalk, MS, LPC, Director of *TeenCentral*, noted that the service received an innovation award from Microsoft in the late 1990s. "*TeenCentral* pioneered the concept of using web-based communications technology to reach teens in need of information, encouragement and support as they deal with the issues that are important to them," Godshalk said.

"Now we're excited to be able to expand and improve on its support for this key population, while continuing to provide the free, anonymous and confidential response service they've come to rely upon," she added
