KidsPeace, a not for profit behavioral health care organization provides emergency and medically necessary care to patients without regard to their ability to pay. KidsPeace recognizes that not all patients have the financial resources to pay for their health care. This Plain Language Summary provides basic information about our Financial Assistance Policy.

Financial Assistance Offered:

Financial assistance eligibility is based on multiple factors including insurance coverage, all income sources, family size, assets and any other relevant special consideration the patient would like considered.

Full or partial assistance may be granted based on the patient's ability to pay for the billed charges.
