## **Family Support Services**

Family and Youth engagement is vital to achieving positive outcomes in residential treatment. The culture, ideas, beliefs, religion, and values of family members play a critical role in the success of the youth and are utilized to support and guide the treatment. Family support will take place via on campus visits, family therapy (therapist of choice on or off campus near family), and Family and Community Time (which includes therapeutic leaves).

**About KidsPeace :** KidsPeace is a private charity dedicated to serving the behavioral and mental health needs of children, families and communities.

Culture of Safety: The KidsPeace Culture of Safety is our initiative to integrate all of our resources to improve safety for all staff, youth, and families. This is emphasized by or utilization of Evidence-Based Practices, Cultural Competence, Trauma-Informed Care, Life Space Crisis Intervention, Model of Care, Ukeru, Safe Crisis Management, Applied Behavioral Analysis, and QPR (Question, Persuade, & Refer).

**Ukeru:** KidsPeace utilizes UKERU, a crisis de-escalation technique and restraint-free approach, which provides an additional resource for staff and youth to stay safe and keep treatment progress moving.

KidsPeace offers TRICARE-certified Adolescent **Residential Treatment Programs at our Orchard** Hills Campus in Pennsylvania. TRICARE certification allows us to provide a complete continuum of care for our clients whose families are in the military.

KidsPeace offers TRICARE-certified Adolescent Residential Treatment Programs and Hospital for emergent psychiatric needs at our Orchard Hills Campus in Pennsylvania.

#### **Admission criteria**

Males (7-18 years of age) and females (10-18 years of age) having a DSM 5 diagnosis indicating the presence of a mental disorder that has had significant impact on the youth's family, school, and or social functioning. Please note additional criteria for the specific specialty residential program the youth is referred to will be considered in determining appropriateness for treatment.

## **TRICARE Intensive Residential Treatment**

Staff-to-Client Ratio 1:3 (males/females age 13-18)

The treatment program is highly specialized, traumainformed, and individualized with an emphasis on the youth and their family. The treatment program incorporates evidence-based, culturally sensitive therapeutic interventions, master's level individual and family therapy, behavior analysis, nursing, psychology and psychiatry.

## **Specialized Behavioral Disorder Treatment**

Staff-to-Client Ratio 1:3, 1:4 (males age 12-18)

This reality and cognitive behavior-based treatment assists youth in accepting responsibility for inappropriate behaviors, identify maladaptive behavioral patterns, increase social sensitivity, develop empathy for victims and learn prosocial skills and long term accountability and self-discipline.

# A.S.P.I.R.E (Adolescent Sexual Preoccupation, Intervention, Responsibility, and Education)

Staff-to-Client Ratio at minimum 1:4 (males age 13-18)

The PRTF-certified ASPIRE residential treatment program provides structured, staff-secure, intensive residential services for male adolescents who are exhibiting high-risk sexualized preoccupations and behaviors. The team utilizes a trauma-informed approach to help youth understand and accept responsibility; identify behavior patterns; increase social sensitivity; increase emotional regulation/expression; increase impulse control and gain understanding of healthy sexual development and relationships.

## **KidsHope Intensive Residential Treatment**

Staff-to-Client Ratio 1:3, 1:4 (males age 12-18)

The PRTF-certified KidsHope Treatment Program provides structured, staff-secure, intensive residential treatment services for male adolescents with intellectual disabilities. Interventions address improving a youth's impulse control, social judgement, emotional regulation/expression and interpersonal skills.

# KidsPeace Trauma, Resiliency, Empowerment, and **Elevation (T.R.E.E.) Residential Program**

Staff-to-Client Ratio 1:3 (males ages 7-18, females ages 10-18)

The PRTF-certified T.R.E.E. Program is designed to address emotional and/or behavioral acuity with youth whom have experienced complex trauma, including Commercial Sexual Exploitation of Children (C-SEC).

# **KidsPeace Hospital** Child and Adolescent Psychiatric Setting

Males/females ages 6-20.5 and under on case-by-case basis

The KidsPeace hospital provides short-term stabilization and assessment for youth with emergent psychiatric needs. Located on the same campus as our TRICARE Residential Programs, the hospital offers a highly structured environment utilizing intensive interventions, comprehensive assessment, support to children and families, and aftercare services. For TRICARE youth receiving treatment in the residential program, the hospital offers a continuum and continuity of care nearly unmatched by any other TRICARE provider.

## **KidsPeace Education Programs**

Serves students Grades 1-12

KidsPeace offers an alternative education program for students requiring a more structured academic environment. Licensed by Pennsylvania Department of Education, KidsPeace schools serve residential and hospital TRICARE programs with appropriate required education.
